

SSHCP Steering Committee 6/7/07

Key Issues/Questions

- **Understand the ‘Rapanos Decision’:** Discuss and understand the implications the Rapanos decision may have on the SSHCP.
- **Discuss County Ownership:** Clarify the acreage and degree to which the County will own and operate preserves verses the use of conservation easements.
- **Preserve Map inside the UDA:** Proposed creation of a map that depicts a ‘realized’ version of what conservation through the SSHCP conservation objectives may represent.
- **Mapping:** Discuss the possibilities of an ‘opt in approach’ for lands outside the UDA where landowners could choose whether or not their property was identified on the map.
- **Resource Set Aside:** Clarify how/if landowners are compensated for resources set asides in the draft plan.
- **Permit Holders:** Understand and resolve the permitting structure. Determine if each entity have a separable permit.
- **Implementing Entity:** Fully describe the implementing entity and how it will function.
- **Creek Corridors:** Fully understand the biology, composition, and on the ground implementation of the various stream corridor requirements.
- **Overall Conservation Ratio:** Discuss the underlying 1:1 conservation ratio. Determine if increased ratios for specific habitats will be reconciled by decreased ratios in others.
- **Above & Beyond:** Discuss the above and beyond component to the conservation strategy and the implications it may have for mitigation.
