Agendized items tentatively include the following policy changes and UCAC priorities: For Chapter 10: Area Plans, the introductory paragraph describing the purpose of area plans, and Chapter 11: Parkway Funding (including expenditures, funding needs, etc.); and deferred topics from the UCAC's early discussion of the River Corridor Management Plan: Parkway operations and maintenance practices, and vegetation and wildlife recommended actions from Chapter 4 of the River Corridor Management Plan (RCMP). Some of these deferred topics may already have been addressed in other chapters. County Planning is currently drafting Chapters 10 & 11 and will identify any remaining issues for UCAC discussion.
