Recommendation:

1. Request individual nominations from the Board of Supervisors for the five Geographic Area Representatives on the Update Citizens Advisory Committee (UCAC).
2. Approve the nomination of Greg Speicher as the boating representative on the UCAC.

BACKGROUND:

The Board of Supervisors approved *The American River Parkway Plan Update: Process Design* and the list of organizations to be represented on the UCAC on June 11, 2003. Once the list of organizations was approved, staff sent invitation letters to the organizations requesting that they self-appoint a representative to the UCAC. On July 29, 2003 the Board of Supervisors approved the individuals to represent the approved list of organizations, excluding the boating community. We held a meeting with representatives from the boating community who have agreed on an individual to represent their interests. We bring forward the boating representative recommendation to you today.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to nominate five individuals to the UCAC. The Clerk of the Board's office has advertised these positions in the open application process. Once the five individuals are nominated, their names will be publicized in the weekly agenda announcements and ratified the following week.
